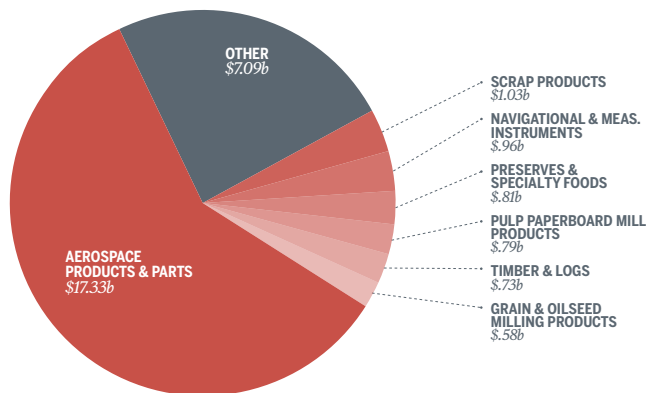
41% ASIA SHARE OF TOTAL STATE EXPORTS
